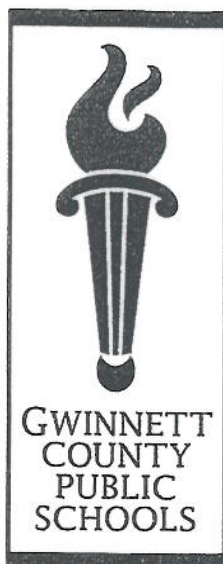


Investigation Summary

Received call from Steve Flynt on the morning of 12/10/08 stating that Eric Davidson, AP @ Central Gwinnett HS had led a student investigation and had determined that several students including [REDACTED] of Dr. Valarie Clark, Principal of Central Gwinnett HS should be suspended pending a disciplinary panel. It was also reported that Eric Davidson had been directed by Dr. Clark not to send any of the students to a disciplinary panel. This conversation was witnessed by Donna Bishop, AP @ Central

All of the students were suspended pending a disciplinary panel including [REDACTED]. During the investigation, Dr. Clark submitted a letter stating that she would be retiring effective 1/01/09 instead of June 1, 2009.
