**AFFIDAVIT OF MASTER POLICE OFFICER HERMAN GREEN**

1.

My name is Herman "Tip" Green and I am over eighteen years of age. I have personal knowledge of and am competent to state the facts contained herein. I am giving this affidavit to be used for any and all lawful purposes.

I am employed as a Master Police Officer in DeKalb County Police Services. I am the officer in charge of automobiles in the custody of Police Services. The automobiles in Police Services custody include cars purchased for Police Services and cars seized as forfeited property that Police Services has been allowed to keep for law enforcement use.

In March of 2008, Chief Bolton saw a Range Rover (worth about \$32,000) in Police Services' possession that was being driven by Major Craddock. Chief Bolton told me that he wanted the Range Rover and that I should give Major Craddock a Suburban instead. I got the Range Rover for Chief Bolton and took it to his house. Around the summer of 2008, Chief Bolton asked me about a Mercedes (worth about \$55,000) in Police Services possession. He asked whether it was a nice car and I responded that it was. He told me that he wanted it. I got the car for him and took it to his house. The Range Rover and Mercedes were seized vehicles that Police Services had been allowed to retain for law enforcement use. I assigned Chief Bolton
