After Chief Bolton was placed on administrative leave with pay on February 9, 2009, I was asked to collect his county vehicles. On Tuesday, February 10, 2009, Chief Bolton's drivers delivered five cars to me. Two of those cars, a 2008 Charger and a 2008 Suburban (3 ton, fully loaded), were brought from Chief Bolton's house. The other three were cars that had been take-home cars used by Chief Bolton's drivers Sgt. Brannon (2008 Crown Victoria), Officer Tealer (2007 Expedition), and Officer Brown (2008 Crown Victoria).

I had someone else retrieve from Police Headquarters a 2007 Crown Victoria that had been assigned to Chief Bolton. Another car that was assigned to Chief Bolton, a 2008 Suburban, was already located at the Bobby Burgess building.

As of February 9, 2009, all seven of the vehicles described in paragraphs 14-15 were assigned for Chief Bolton's use or the use of Chief Bolton's drivers. However, these vehicles were not assigned to Chief Bolton's cost center because he had previously directed me not to assign cars to his cost center. To comply with Chief Bolton's direction, I assigned the vehicles to the following cost centers: special ops (4614), CID (4613), or uniform (4617). I told Chief Rancifer that I was assigning the cars reserved for Chief Bolton's use to other cost centers at Chief Bolton's direction.
