5. They started calling him snitch, gay, virgin, you ugly from September 2008 to April 2009 on numerous occasions. They threatened him and attacked him in the bathroom in December 2008 choking him until he passed out. They physical assaulted him by pushing him and brushing up against him in a threatening manner. She found out about these incidents from Jaheem, his sister, his friends and other parents. No school administrator told the mother about these incidents.
6. Yes, Jaheem told [REDACTED] the principal [REDACTED] and the school counselor on multiple occasions.
7. Yes, Jaheem told his mother on multiple occasions and she reported it to the school administration on multiple occasions. She mainly talked with [REDACTED] about the issues with bullying.

9. Yes, she spoke on multiple occasions with Staff but no action was taken by staff.
10. Nothing was done. [REDACTED] indicated that action would be taken especially about the choking incident. No meeting of the parents occurred and [REDACTED] wrongly suspended Jaheem for an alleged fight in which he was the victim of an assault. The mother was never contacted about the physical assault in the bathroom.

12. Yes, She has his report card, and his school records as supplied by the school district recently.

14. Please see the school records from his classroom.
15. Enforce the school bullying policy, Punish the bullies, stop suspending children that were only attacked by the bullies, take the complaints of parents seriously, and terminate immediately all school staff that knew or should have known about the problem and did nothing.
16. No, we have reached out to the administration on several occasions with no response.
17. Yes, the death of his grandmother in October 2008...however the bullying directly caused his mood change from August 2008 until April 2009 and ultimately caused the act of suicide.
