

"Masika Carrasquillo [Bermudez] stated that she had been attacked and beaten in the kitchen of their town home by the father of her children, Norman Montgomery Keene. Carrasquillo [Bermudez] told dispatch that Keene and his brother and brother's girlfriend had left the residence. . .I observed the suspect vehicle leaving the neighborhood and turned around to initiate a traffic stop. . .Keene was the back seat passenger in the car and jumped out of the car in an irate manner and started yelling that this was crazy. I ordered Keene to sit back in the car until back-up arrived and then approached the car. Keene continued to yell in the car and throw his arms around in a child-like tantrum screaming, 'She is the devil.'

Officer interviewed [Bermudez] Carrasquillo who stated that the incident started in the kitchen. She stated that only she and Keene were in the kitchen and had been arguing about going to the farmer's market to buy groceries. She stated that he told her she would have to wait and then she asked him, 'Why is it that when your brother asks you to go somewhere, you jump right in the car, but when I ask you to go somewhere, I have to wait?'

**At this point she stated that he lunged across the kitchen and grabbed her by the throat, shoving her against the east wall. They struggled in the kitchen and she stated that he struck her in the back with a metal kitchen table chair also leaving a dent and black mark on the refrigerator and a matching mark on her back that fit the curvature of the chair. Carrasquillo [Bermudez] fell to the ground and when she fell to the ground she stated he kicked her in the throat leaving several marks on the left side of her throat. The struggle and the noise brought their two young children and Keene's brother, Sean Nesbitt, downstairs. When Nesbitt saw them struggling, she stated he grabbed her and held her arms, at this point Keene swung a right fist into her left temple and she pulled away, trying to get to the kitchen phone to call 911. Nesbitt apparently took the two children back upstairs. Carrasquillo [Bermudez] stated Keene went to physically block her from calling 911, holding up his arms, preventing her from getting to the phone. Then suddenly as it had started, Keene, Nesbitt and Nesbitt's girlfriend [name omitted] left the house through the back door and she was able to call Police.**

Keene was arrested on state warrants for Family Violence Battery and *Obstructing an Emergency Phone Call*. He was transported to Rockdale County Jail without further incident. Carrasquillo's [Bermudez] injuries were photographed and entered into the report. **She was transported to Rockdale County Hospital for her injuries to ensure that no blood clots**
