
Dear Mayor Longino and Council Members:

On behalf of the Georgia Interlocal Risk Management Agency ("GIRMA") and its third party administrator, Gallagher Bassett Services, Inc., notice is hereby given to the City of College Park as Named Member pursuant to Section III, Paragraph A.3. of the Member Coverage Agreement that GIRMA proposes to settle the above referenced claim. The terms of the proposed settlement call for (1) payment of \$740,000 to the Plaintiff; (2) the Plaintiff dropping his demand for any kind of letter of reference or apology from any of the Defendants; (3) a dismissal of the individual Defendants with prejudice as a pre-condition to a final settlement, which would then occur between the City and Plaintiff; (4) a dismissal with prejudice of the lawsuit pending in the federal district court as to the only remaining Defendant, the City of College Park; and (5) dismissal of the matter on appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. Should the City fail to consent to a settlement recommended by GIRMA, GIRMA will not be liable for any "Excess Amount" as that term is defined in the Member Coverage Agreement, and GIRMA may invoke the options set out in the Reservation of Rights letter dated March 17, 2008 that I sent you on GIRMA's behalf.
