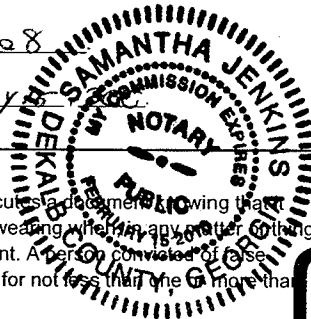

PENALTIES: False Swearing

A person to whom a lawful oath or affirmation has been administered or who executes a document purporting to be an acknowledgment of a lawful oath or affirmation commits false swearing, whether in any matter, other than a judicial proceeding, he knowingly and willfully makes a false statement. A person convicted of false swearing shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not less than one or more than years, or both.
