I am in receipt of your correspondence of October 24, 2011, regarding File No. 11-106 – a complaint received by your office which alleged that Governor Deal used his office for personal gain and had Patrick Millsaps, Chairman of the Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission ("GGTCFC"), "get rid of Executive Secretary Stacey Kalberman." Per your request, I have inquired of Governor Deal on the questions posed.

First, Governor Deal did not have any discussion with Director Millsaps or anyone from the GGTCFC regarding personnel transactions relating to Stacey Kalberman. Second and in response to your question 3), Governor Deal did not have any type of communications with Director Millsaps regarding "getting rid of" Stacey Kalberman.
